The First Events

- "Wow, I can't believe I walked that much in a day!"

- "I didn't realize I was causing them to..."
- "Can we make a cart to present these materials?"
- "I can't believe how much space I have without the WIP!"



Problem Solving and Lean

- A problem is a GAP
- A gap between what should be happening and what is happening





Leading by Questioning

- Lean Leaders perfect the art of questioning
- Why and How questions vs. Who questions
- Teaching vs. telling

What have you learned?















As we focused on Lean Management...

- 5S slipped



















- Lean Tools and Lean Management dual focus

- Teach and practice real problem solving


